1a. Forming a steering committee

- Observation made that existing steering committee roster does not include members representing international programs/activities.
- Formation of steering committee is next step for leadership; once established will make policy decisions with input from members and advisory board.

- Steering committee does not necessarily rubberstamp existing mission statement it will be open to suggestions for changes in mission statement once formed.
- Once steering committee is created, advisory committee should be regularly consulted, voting process by which proposals can be made should be outlined.

Consensus reached to continue with forming steering committee; charge of steering committee – 'including, but not limited to, the creation of bylaws.'

1b. Composition of steering committee

- Important to note that the steering committee has not yet signed on all of the individuals listed on the proposed slate. Consensus must be made on approving the *categories* listed, not necessarily the people. Once a steering committee is formed, its composition may be changed/improved.
- Draft of steering committee composition put together by Bob Rosenberg and fellow committee members was taken into consideration while forming existing structure.
- Suggestions made to expand members of steering and advisory committees to include representatives from Canada, Mexico, etc. after initial steering committee is formed as IPM is global in scope.
- Composition of existing steering committee approved by call participants.

2. Formation of Advisory Committee

No objections made regarding establishing an advisory committee.

3. Mission Statement

 Consensus (18 yes, 2 no, 2 abstain) reached to accept existing mission statement formed by the transition group after the Phoenix meeting as a beginning point - may later be edited.

Don Parker and Tim Muench cannot approve of mission statement based on legal confinements of respective organizations concerning the connotations and implications of the word 'advocate.'
